

# Leadership Development Citizenship Education Institute Association of North Carolina Alphas Frequently Asked Questions

- *Student to Chaperone Ratio?* 7:1
- *Do Chaperones have background checks?* Yes
- *Are meals covered in the Institute tuition?* All meals are covered in the Institute tuition.
- *Lodging?* Institute lodging will be on the campus of UNC-Wilmington.
- *Transportation?* Institute tuition includes transportation to and from UNC-Wilmington. Registrants will select pick up and return from three locations: Charlotte Metro Area, Greensboro Area and Raleigh-Durham Airport Area.
- *Clothing?* Students should dress as they would attending their high school. On Sunday, students need to be dressed in business attire for the Institute closing ceremony and official photograph.
- *Can parents, guardians, and mentors participate?* Parents, guardians, and mentors may attend the Institute closing activities at their own expense.
- *What is the cost of the experience?* The Institute cost is \$400.00 per student (includes \$150.00 non-refundable security deposit).
- *Is there a payment plan?* Yes, however, the balance of tuition is due June 15, 2026.
- *Do students need any additional funds?* No
- *Who may register for the Institute?* Students who are rising to grades 9 through 12 may register.
- *What learning modules will be covered during the Institute?* The 4-day, 3-night Institute will focus on Transformational Leadership; Community Building; Professional Branding; and College & Career Readiness
- *Will students be expected to journal?* Yes, students will be expected to reflect and journal each day. Journal time and materials will be provided.
- *Requests for Refunds?* Requests for refunds will be handled on a case-by-case basis and may incur an administrative fee.
- *Packing List?* A packing list will be sent to all registered students.
